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**Code of Ethics Policy Document**

Shri Pandit Prem Nath Dogra Government Degree College Samba is committed to shaping young minds into responsible citizens through a values-driven and morally grounded education. Our faculty and students exemplify this commitment by adhering to the following ethical principles:

- All students are regarded as equals, regardless of gender, religion, caste, or creed.
- Students are expected to attend classes punctually and regularly.
- Wearing the designated uniform is mandatory while on campus.
- Smoking and the consumption of alcohol are strictly prohibited within college premises.
- Indecent behaviour towards any member of the opposite sex shall not be tolerated.
- Any damage to college property shall be charged to the responsible individual.
- Demonstrations of any kind are not permitted during operational hours on campus.
- Ragging or any form of harassment is a criminal offense and shall be reported to law enforcement.
- Littering on campus is prohibited. The college maintains a plastic-free environment, banning the use of single-use plastics.
- Students must maintain a minimum attendance of 75%; failure to do so shall result in ineligibility to sit for exams.
- Impersonation during roll calls or examinations is a serious offense and shall be met with stringent penalties.
- Students are encouraged to cultivate virtues such as hard work, patience and tolerance.
- Teachers are expected to arrive at college on time and to complete the syllabus within the designated timeframe.
- Faculty members should maintain professionalism and decorum both in and outside the classroom, serving as exemplary role models for students.
- No teacher shall use inappropriate language towards any staff member or student.
- Teachers should provide mentorship and counselling to students as needed.
- In addition to their teaching responsibilities, faculty shall actively participate in all assigned co-curricular activities.
- Teachers must inform the head of the institution before taking any leave.
- Non-teaching staff are required to adhere strictly to college schedules and fulfil all assigned duties.
- Staff members should communicate using respectful and dignified language.
- All members of the college community are expected to behave responsibly by adhering to the established rules and regulations of the institution.
